Citizen Science HD is a K-12 STEM program administered by the Emory Center for Advancing Health & Diversity through Citizen Science. In collaboration with the University of Georgia, Citizen Science HD has worked hand-in-hand with our TMS STEM Cohort to research, develop and roll-out a mosquito monitoring and control program. Entitled B.I.T.E. (Biological Investigations with Technology & Engineering), Cohort students, under the guidance of Guha Dhrmarajan, an Assistant Research Science at UGA's Savannah River Ecology Laboratory, engaged in the design and construction of mosquito traps as well as the collection and analysis of subsequent data. Results were presented at an event sponsored with one of our Advocate Partners, Northrup Grumman.

Additionally, Citizen Science HD held an after-school year-long workshop focused on cancer research, engaging our students in the collection and analysis of actual data, culminating in student-spearheaded presentations at year end.
