

Tucker Middle STEM Program Expectations

1. Program Expectations

• Students must maintain an average of **80 or above** in all core classes AND STEM/technology AND maintain a clean disciplinary record

2. Performance Expectations

- Complete and turn in all assignments on time.
- Maintain the TMS STEM Digital Notebook.
- Maintain a TMS STEM Journal.
- Work in collaborative groups.
- Actively contribute to classroom discussions and activities.
- Participate in at least one STEM competition and/or CTSO.

3. Performance Evaluation

Students will be assessed at the end of each nine-week grading period. Students that are not
meeting Program Expectations will be placed on Program Probation. This means that they have
until the end of the next 9-week grading period to improve their status and meet program
requirements. If requirements have not been met by the end of this period, the student will be
removed from the STEM program.

4. Program Probation

• Students on Program Probation for failing to meet performance expectations will be responsible for addressing concerns as expressed by TMS staff.

5. Program Succession

• Students will **automatically progress** to the next year of the program providing they are in good standing with the program.
